## **WARRANTY INFORMATION**

All Krowne Metal Corporation (KMC) refrigeration products are warranted to be free of defects in material and workmanship within one year of factory ship date.

### WARRANTY FORM

A warranty form is included with this manual and must be completed and faxed to KMC at (973) 872-1129. Registration must be complete within 2 weeks of install. Failure to do so may void labor warranty.

### **ONE YEAR PARTS & LABOR WARRANTY**

**PARTS WARRANTY:** Any part found defective under normal use within one year of factory ship date will be replaced by KMC. Warranty is void in the absence of proper maintenance, operation and authorized service. Warranty is also void on units that have been damaged in freight, field altered, lack of proper electrical requirements, fire, flood or natural disaster.

**REPLACEMENT PARTS:** Must be returned to KMC prepaid. Credit will be issued upon return and inspection of defective part.

**LABOR WARRANTY:** Labor service **MUST** be approved by KMC before work is done. If authorization is not obtained warranty is void. KMC is not responsible for any loss of product or sales during that time. Any additional costs due to after hour services or excessive travel time (more than an hour) will be incurred by end user. Labor warranty covers all 50 states.

## **5 YEAR COMPRESSOR WARRANTY**

Compressor is covered by a 5 year replacement warranty and a one year labor warranty from the original factory ship date.



### **INSTALLATION**

At Krowne Metal Corporation (KMC) we are dedicated to customer satisfaction. This installation guide is provided to clarify and answer any questions you may have regarding our line of Mug Frosters. Please read this guide before attempting installation or operation. Thank you for choosing KMC as your Mug Froster provider.

#### UNCRATING

Remove all shipping material from unit before operation. Please inspect unit for any hidden freight damage and report any damage immediately to Krowne Metal Corp. If included, install optional casters or legs to bottom of unit. Please avoid turning unit on it's side or rear to install accessories. If this can not be avoided, unit must be left in the upright position for 24 hrs before operating. All units come equipped with pre-determined mounting holes and self starting screws for easy install. (screws are provided only when casters or legs are ordered from factory). It is important to check that casters or legs are securely attached with appropriate mounting hardware.

#### **ELECTRICAL REQUIREMENTS**

115 Volt AC, 1 Phase, 60Hz. We recommend using a dedicated 15 amp circuit minimum. 8'-0" grounded cord standard. \*\* **DO NOT PLUG UNIT INTO A GFI OUTLET** \*\*

#### PLUMBING

All units have an evaporating pan and do not require any plumbing hook-up.

#### **INSTALLING OF SHELVES**

Shelves can be installed based on owner's preference.

#### LOCATION

Place unit in desired location and level. Allow 2" clearance on left side or at rear of unit for proper air flow (both recommended). **DO NOT BLOCK OR OBSTRUCT FRONT GRILL.** 

#### FLOOR SEALING

If required, unit can be sealed to floor using a NSF approved clear silicone. Excess sealant should be wiped clean.



## **OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE**

#### **OPERATING TEMPERATURE**

The operating temperature of the Mug Froster is pre-set at the factory for an average of  $0^{\circ}$ . Average operating range is from  $-5^{\circ}$  to  $5^{\circ}$ .

#### LOADING

Units can be filled with mugs, glasses or plates which should be dry and at room temperature. Allow 25-30 minutes for proper cleaning.

#### DEFROSTING

Automatic defrost is standard on all KMC mug frosters. Auto defrost will occur every 4 hours for approximately 20 minutes. **NOTE:** Fans inside the unit will turn off during this cycle.

If evaporator coil freezes up and a manual defrost is needed, press the DOWN button for more than 3 seconds until DEF is displayed on the thermostat screen.

An automatic fullbox defrost will be performed every day from 5 AM to 9 AM.



#### **CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS**

Make sure to avoid all products which may corrode the stainless steel such as steel wool and chlorine based bleaches. The cooler should be cleaned with a mild detergent, warm water and a soft cloth. All cleaning materials should be washed away and the cooler completely dried.

**Condenser must be cleaned every 60 days or may void warranty.** Remove front grill for access to condenser. If the condenser is not cleaned regularly loss of efficiency and ultimately condenser failure may occur.

Doors, door gaskets and exterior should be cleaned daily to prevent buildup of liquids and other matter that may interfere with operation. Interior of unit should be cleaned regularly. To clean these surfaces use a mild detergent, warm water and a soft cloth. Dry completely!






## **WIRING DIAGRAM**

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

#### 1. Why is my froster not turning on?


- A. Make sure unit is plugged in.
- B. Make sure unit is not plugged into a GFI receptacle.
- C. Check to see if circuit breaker is off.

#### 2. Why was my froster working but now has shut off?

- A. Check to see if circuit breaker is off.
- B. Make sure unit is not plugged into a GFI receptacle.

#### 3. Why is my froster running (compressor noise) but not getting cold?

- A. Make sure condenser is clean. Remove front grill to inspect.
- B. Check that there is adequate air flow. DO NOT RESTRICT AIRFLOW AT REAR, LEFT AND FRONT. (see diagram below)
- C. Check to see if evaporator is frozen. If so, push Manual Defrost Button located on front of unit.
- D. Check interior of unit. Make sure evaporator is clear. Do not load froster fully to top. This will restrict airflow.
